

HOW TO BEGIN

Step 1: Submit Your Volunteer Application

Visit ww.hssc.org/volunteer/ to complete your volunteer application.

You will need to create an account with VolunteerHub, our online volunteer scheduling system.

Step 2: Attend an Information Session

Your application will be reviewed, then you will be contacted about attending an upcoming Volunteer Information Session.

During the one-hour information session, held at our facility, you'll learn about the expectations and rewards of volunteering for HSSC.

Step 3: Complete Your Training

Learn the ropes through role-based training courses.

There is a one-time \$35 fee that covers your volunteer t-shirt, name badge, insurance, and training materials.

AT A GLANCE

- All volunteers must be able to work independently and follow shelter guidelines and rules.
- Volunteers interacting with animals should be able to bend, stoop, and have adequate vision in order to recognize animal body language and expressions.
- We ask for a minimum commitment of 6 hours per month (2 hours of which will include cleaning) for the first 3 months, with an annual requirement of 50 hours.
